Over time our work has developed its own distinctive signature, based in Italian cutting techniques “battuto” combined with Swedish overlay. In these techniques we have been pioneering and unique in the field. Color, light, texture, pattern, and shape together allow us to reveal an undercurrent of meaning and value, adhering to the simplest of forms and clear lines.

Although our work has become more sculptural over the years, we seek to imbue everything we do with the deepest connection to archetypal forms and shapes, and seek the highest level of craftsmanship in all our works. We try to honour eternal symbols of human culture and history, while embracing contemporary evolution in form and meaning.

We have always been migratory creatures and in the recent years some of the large installations are representing our deep concerns for the world we have created and share with all.
